

To all who wish to use Lake of the Sacred Heart,

Christ the King is blessed to include a private lake for camping, swimming, and waterfront activities available for our guests. With this blessing comes the responsibility of usage in accordance with our ministry mission, stewardship of what God has provided and safety for all of God's people.

Unfortunately, we have experienced an alarming increase in blatant disregard for safety directives and deliberate property damage to that which God has entrusted to our care.

Thus, we need your cooperation. The lake and campsite are no longer open to public convenience. Those wishing to avail themselves of this privilege must apply for a pass available at the Welcome Center of Christ the King. They must agree to abide by the following usage and safety considerations:

- Guests authorized to use the Lake must complete a **Lake Usage Waiver** and will be issued a pass.
- Guests may use the Lake during designated times. Summer camp, guests staying at the Center and Groups booked through the Center have priority over all other guests.
- Guests with a pass must sign in and out at the beachfront regardless of their lake activity.
- Guests must obey all rules posted for camping, swimming and boating. This includes the use of personal floatation devices and proper use of all equipment. Dogs are not permitted in the swimming area. Conservative bathing attire required, no bikinis please.
- Alcohol is not permitted.
- Guests who show a propensity toward disregarding the rules and regulations determined at the sole discretion of CtK staff will lose Lake Privileges.
